Dear Sir/Madam,

Following a serious incident concerning breach of copyright which resulted in legal action by a Content Owner, coupled with concerns raised by the CDSA (Content Delivery and Storage Association) that some orders are exposing their Clients, intermediaries/Duplication companies such as Dischromatics, replication companies such as Sony DADC and themselves to unreasonably high levels of risk of copyright infringement, our Anti-Piracy procedures as of 30th March 2009 have been updated for better protection of all involved parties.

The main concern was that the existing Anti-Piracy system did not provide sufficient material proof that companies such as Dischromatics or you as our Clients (where you are not the Content Owner) are legally authorised to copy master discs supplied.

As the nature of this issue is so severe, all reputable manufacturers and brokers have implemented or will be implementing a very similar system in the near future as no-one can afford to take these risks any longer.

For this reason, we have been supplied with an '*Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Form*' which meets the requirements of the CDSA and which we will require to be completed and submitted with all orders for pre-recorded discs (replicated or duplicated, CDs or DVDs). The IPR Form must be completed and signed by the individual or organisation **soliciting reproduction of the master data** and cannot be signed by Dischromatics.

- Where you are the Content Owner of the material, this will be confirmed by your signature on the IPR Form.
- Where you are **NOT** the Content Owner of the material (i.e. it has been licensed from the Content Owner), additional information must be provided by you and a copy of the respective license(s) must be provided.
- The IPR Form and copies of all relevant licenses must then be submitted to Dischromatics at the time of ordering where master data is being supplied (i.e. not reorders of products with no change in master data). Unfortunately, one form will be required per title (so if a 7-disc set is being produced, 7 signed forms will be required). These completed forms **must** be supplied at the time of ordering as we will be unable to begin production without them.
- These forms **do not** replace the normal MCPS or performance licences that are required for Audio products so please continue to supply these in the normal way.

The blank IPR form is separately attached to this email for you to use when you next place an order with Dischromatics. Completed, signed forms can be accepted by fax, email or snail mail.
